Differences in Installation	<p><u>Paving blocks are ready to use instantly upon installation.</u></p> <p><u>Paving stones can easily be removed and replaced if there are any problems such as subsurface sinkage etc.</u></p> <p><u>Simple and cost effective to repair or reinstall paver blocks.</u></p>	<p><u>Concreting the road takes excessive time and is unusable until curing process is complete.</u></p> <p><u>Concrete tends to crack in various places and is hard and expensive to repair. (ageing, low drainage, sub-surface sinkage tree roots etc can cause concrete to crack and get displaced)</u></p>
		
Differences in Durability	<p><u>Pavers are rated to be four times as strong as a typical concrete roads,</u></p> <p><u>Pavers are extremely flexible and are able to disperse the pressure or weight evenly, which prevents cracking.</u></p>	<p><u>Concrete roads are prone to splitting and cracking if the ground beneath it shifts. Additionally, changes in temperature can cause the concrete to expand and contract, which will also result in cracking.</u></p>
